The point(s) at which fish and fish products may enter a chain of custody:

This certificate extends to the first point of sale. Product from the eligible members only is authorised to enter into MSC Chain of Custody certifications programmes.

The limit of identification of landings is the landing of *Pandalus borealis* by member vessels at recognised ports where appropriate recording and monitoring of landings takes place. *Pandalus borealis* products landed by any of the vessels owned by any of the member companies are eligible to enter further CoCs. Companies buying directly from this fishery are required to have CoC certification. Any companies buying from the vessels owned by any of the member companies must also seek CoC certification in order to sell product as MSC.

Pandalus montagui has been identified as an IPI stock and, as such, has been assessed and is considered eligible to enter further chains of custody. As long as the proportion of *Pandalus montagui* does not exceed 2% then product will be eligible to carry the MSC logo

The parties, or categories of parties, that are entitled to use this certificate to enter fish from the certified fishery into certified chains of custody:

Client group: All Greenland fishing companies holding a licence for prawn fishery in West Greenland. Name, international call sign and harbor identification shall be entered in the licence to document the eligibility of (a) vessel(s) to fish under the MSC fishery certification.
