MSC Chain of Custody certification will commence from change of ownership at the point of landing from the certified trawler company to either the sales or the processing company, all members of Sustainable Fisheries Greenland. The Chain of Custody will commence following sale of frozen, landed Greenland halibut products at the points of landing and land-based processing sites must have separate Chain of Custody certification.
