This certificate is valid for the following Scope:

Greenland lumpfish (*Cyclopterus lumpus*) targeted in West Greenland waters, NAFO 1A-1F (FAO area 21) using gillnet as harvest method.

This certificate extends to the first point of landing. MSC Chain of Custody certification will commence from the point of landing, and land-based processing sites must have separate Chain of Custody certification.

Parties entitled to use the certificate to enter fish from the certified fishery into certified chains of custody are all fishermen holding a Greenland lumpfish fishing license and landing the catch to processors in Greenland that are current members of Sustainable Fisheries Greenland according to the latest list published on the MSC website.
